## Food and Beverage Booths

With your participation we will be able to offer this event free to the public. Your partnership is a valued component enabling the lost of Southern Humboldt free access to the gospel. Thank you for your participation.

Please be creative in your meal choices as this will give the event attendees a positive and exciting experience.

All of the Jesus Rocks the Redwoods food and beverage booths will be from Christian ministries.

We would like every food and beverage booth will benefit Christian churches, their ministries, and missions. All vendors will pay a \$100.00 booth fee. This money will offset the event costs to be able to help keep this event free to the public. **Please make checks payable to: Jesus Rocks The Redwoods.** All profit from your booth is yours to keep however we will accept donations from your proceeds if you feel led to do so.

There will be several different meal choices on a first come first serve basis. If a group signs up for hamburgers first, they exclusively get to serve hamburgers and no one else will have that option. Do not consider that you are able to sell the item you have chosen until you hear back from JRTR administration.

You will need to provide your own booth, cooking source, tables, chairs and anything else you need for your product.

Portable toilets will be positioned in compliance with Humboldt County Food Facility code for you.

Please select 3 choices for food items that you would like to sell at the event. You will be given your first choice if another vendor has not reserved and paid for it. **It will not be OK to sell anything that has not been approved by JRTR administration! If you do you will be asked to leave and your \$100.00 deposit will not be refunded.**

**All performing artists and speakers traveling over 100 miles will be given 2 free meal passes.** Please honor these passes. These people have left their homes to serve others and the Church here is honored to be able to take care of their needs. If this is a hardship for you please contact me and we can discuss options for you.

Each booth should be no larger than 12'x12' you will be able to utilize the immediate area directly behind your booth for some storage. Please keep the area you use neat and organized during the event. Spots will be assigned by JRTR staff as they are reserved and paid for.

Vendors could start to set up their booths **after 3:00 Friday July 22<sup>nd</sup>**. You will need to check in with JRTR staff to find out where your booth is located. Do not set up a booth anywhere until you check in with Jesus Rocks The Redwoods staff.

**Please have your booth set up and manned by 9:00 AM July 23<sup>rd</sup>**. It is OK if you are not ready to serve at 9:00. Although the event program starts at 10:00, the public will be allowed to enter at 9:00AM. We would like all vendors in the park and their vehicles parked by 9:00 to help minimize traffic. The gate will be unlocked at 8:00AM for you to enter on the day of the event.

Please have a clearly posted sign on your booth with your church name and/or ministry or mission it is supporting. This will allow your customers to know who they are supporting, may increase your sales, and offer ministry opportunities.

Please have a large enough sign with the items you are selling for customers to read from a distance. This may limit confusion and increase your sales.

Please clearly post your prices. This may limit confusion, shorten your customer's wait in line, and increase your sales. A chalk or wipe off board will work well for this and allow you to make changes as needed.

Water is available on site. Please bring your own containers to carry it to your booth.

Your booth is your responsibility and not the responsibility of Jesus Rocks the Redwoods. You must abide by all of the current Humboldt County health codes that pertain to a temporary food facility. *JRTR is not liable for any health code violations.*

You must have the Humboldt County Division of Environmental Health Temporary Food Facility permit application (included) filled with the county, for this event, at least 2 weeks prior to the event and **your stamped permit with you at check in**. The permit must be posted in your booth on the day of the event. A hand washing station is necessary for any booth that prepares or serves food. This sounds scary but it is not. They just want to make sure you are safe with the food you serve.

No stakes are to be driven into the park ground. You will find sand bags and water jugs will hold your canopy down. No vehicles are to be driven on the park lawn. You may be fined by the California State park if you violate these park rules.

Electricity is not available to vendors. Please if you have to have a generator, go through event administration for permission. Generators without approval will be asked to be shut off. A lot of site generators will make the environment uncomfortable for event attendees. Please be considerate and use alternative means to store and cook your food where possible, unless you have an ultra quiet one.

Booths should be taken down *after* the event but no later than **Sunday July 24<sup>th</sup>**. At noon You may be unable to keep your property if it is left after this date. You can empty your booth *quietly* during the event but please leave the booth itself in tact until after the last artist performs. This will ensure a less distracting environment for event attendees. Please do not move your vehicle to do this until the program has ended.
